The tools and approach used are based on best practices used by leading companies known for superior execution Effective management controls help address both planning and execution deficiencies, and are a critical component driving the success of major change initiatives, such as Lean Manufacturing and Six Sigma, in high reliability organizations.

 - o Derive annual objectives, x-matrix, and implementation roadmap.
- Functions define functional objectives, roadmaps and projects.
 - o Deploy roadmap to teams, define projects, and set targets.
- Teams develop improvement actions for lines, groups, and teams.
 - o Implement plans, track progress on the balanced scorecard.
 - Review weekly sprints, monthly progress, and quarterly impact.

 - Output control,
 - o Behavioural control, and
 - Clan control to drive the achievement of results

- Using Statistical Process Control methodology to monitor and control process KPIs
- Identifying when managerial action is needed to correct process deviations
- Ensuring consistency with related processes
